The Community-based case manager will be highly skilled in navigating complex medical and social systems and dedicated to ensuring their clients move toward their goals.

Essential Functions:

- Assesses clients with problems related to personal and family adjustments, finances, employment, food, housing, physical and mental impairments and home care to determine the nature and degree of need.
- Completes comprehensive assessments which identify medical, psychological and social factors contributing to client's situation
- Develops individualized care plans
- Refers clients to JFS programs and community resources
- Maintains records and reports
- Provides outreach training to agencies, congregations and organizations
- Represents JFS in meetings in the community
