### **Title**

Clinical Manager

Safe Connections is hiring for Clinical Manager. This newly created position will provide oversight and supervision of the Adult Individual Therapy program, including Safe Connections programming provided through our collaboration with Rung for Women and Provident Behavioral Health.

Additional duties include: oversight of compliance with established policy and procedures to meet best practice and productivity standards, hiring and training new therapists, conducting yearly performance reviews, program evaluation and support of the clinical case audit process and quality improvement activities. Monitors staffing trends. Position responsibilities will take place onsite at the Safe Connections office and remotely.

### **Qualifications**

Master's degree in Counseling, Social Work, Psychology or related field; LCSW or LPC licensure plus 3 years or more direct experience post licensure providing clinical supervision and program oversight to a multidisciplinary team, 3 years of experience providing culturally-sensitive, gender affirming therapy with clients on issues related to intimate partner and sexual violence, trauma and concurring symptoms. Proficient with Microsoft Suite and web-based documentation to monitor program trends and support agency program evaluation. Experience with tele-behavioral health is beneficial.
