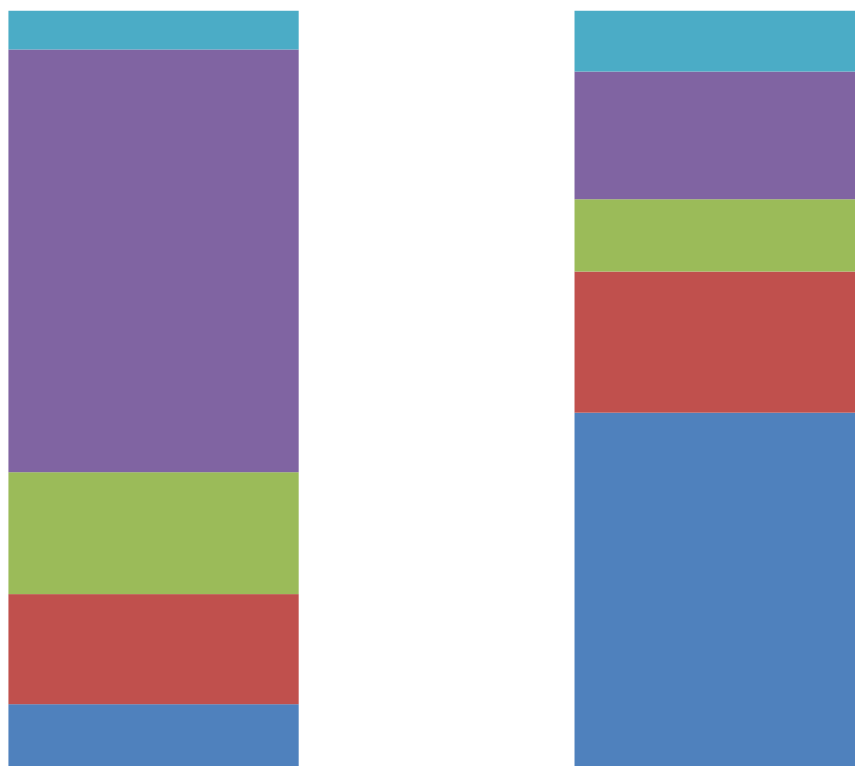

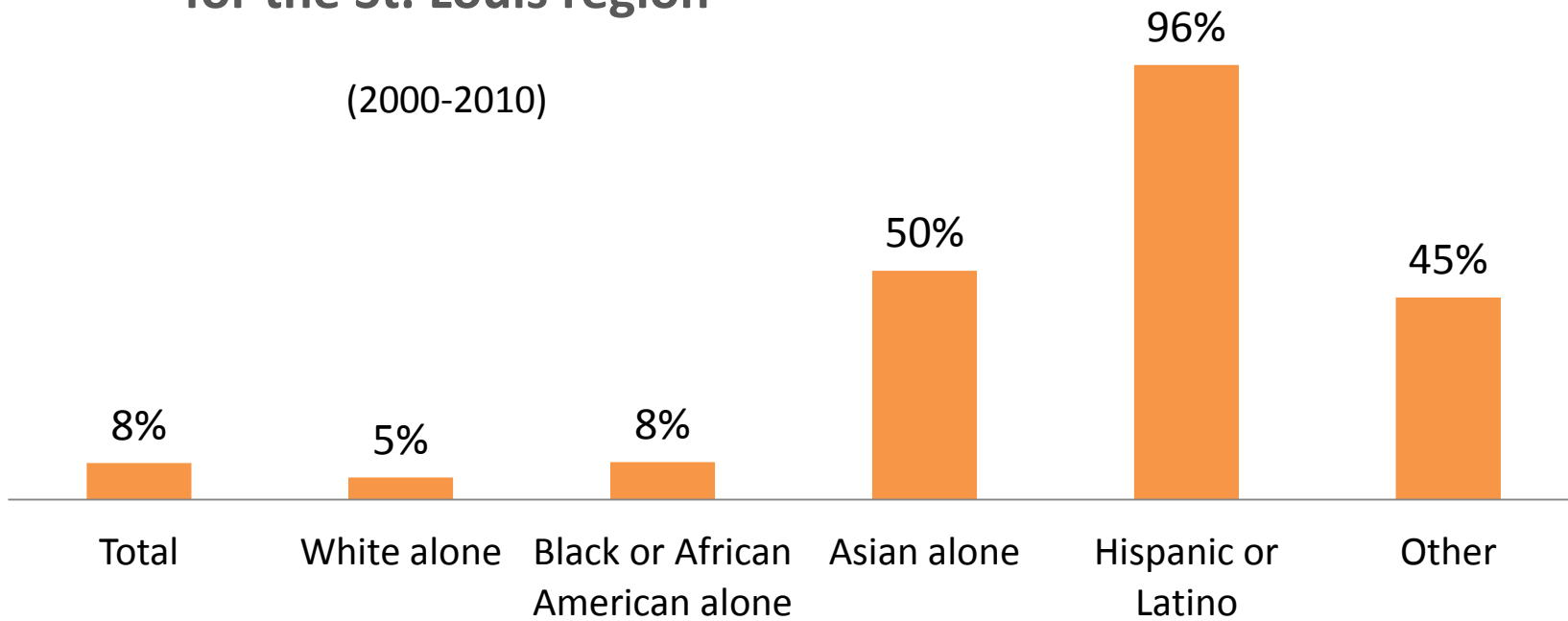

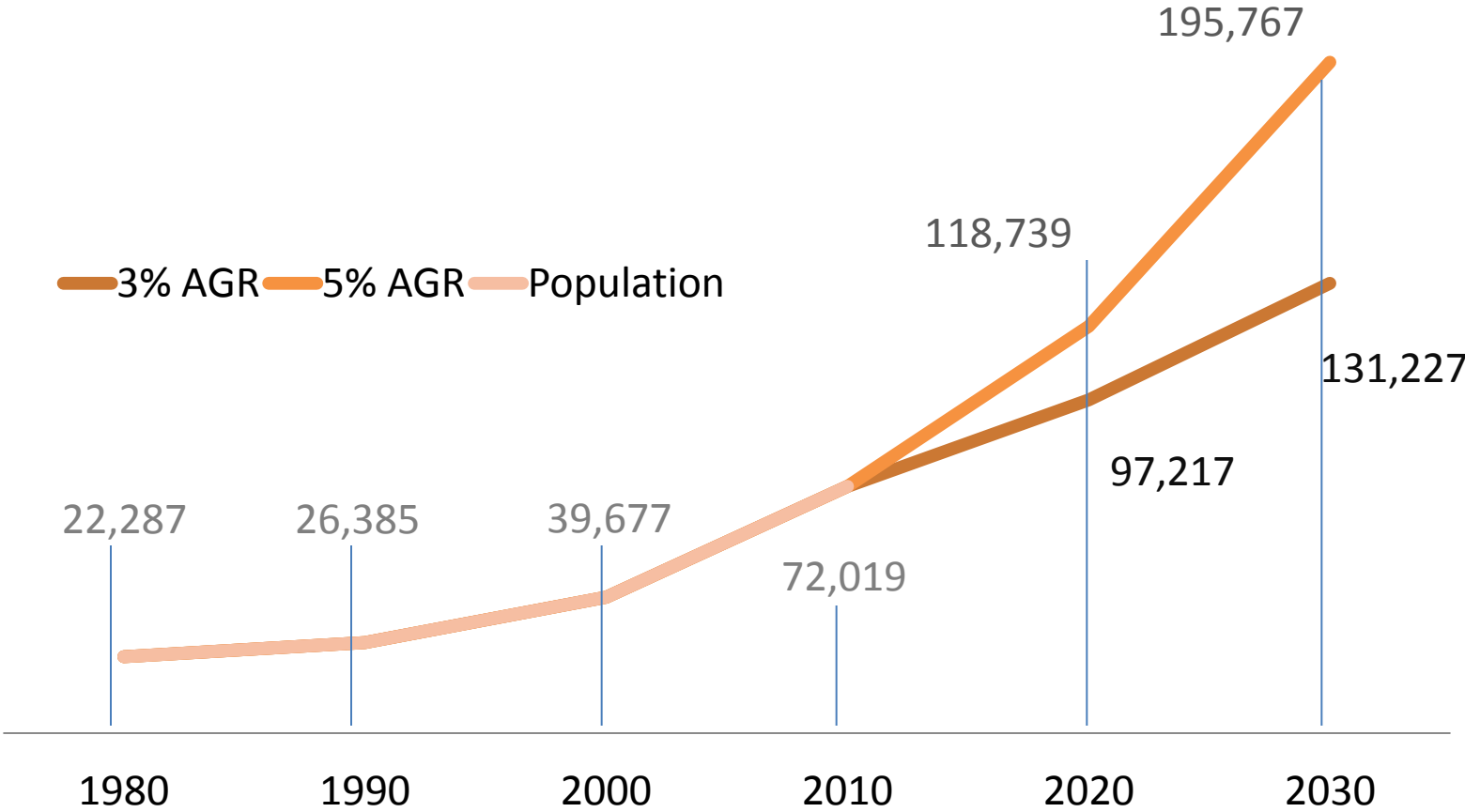

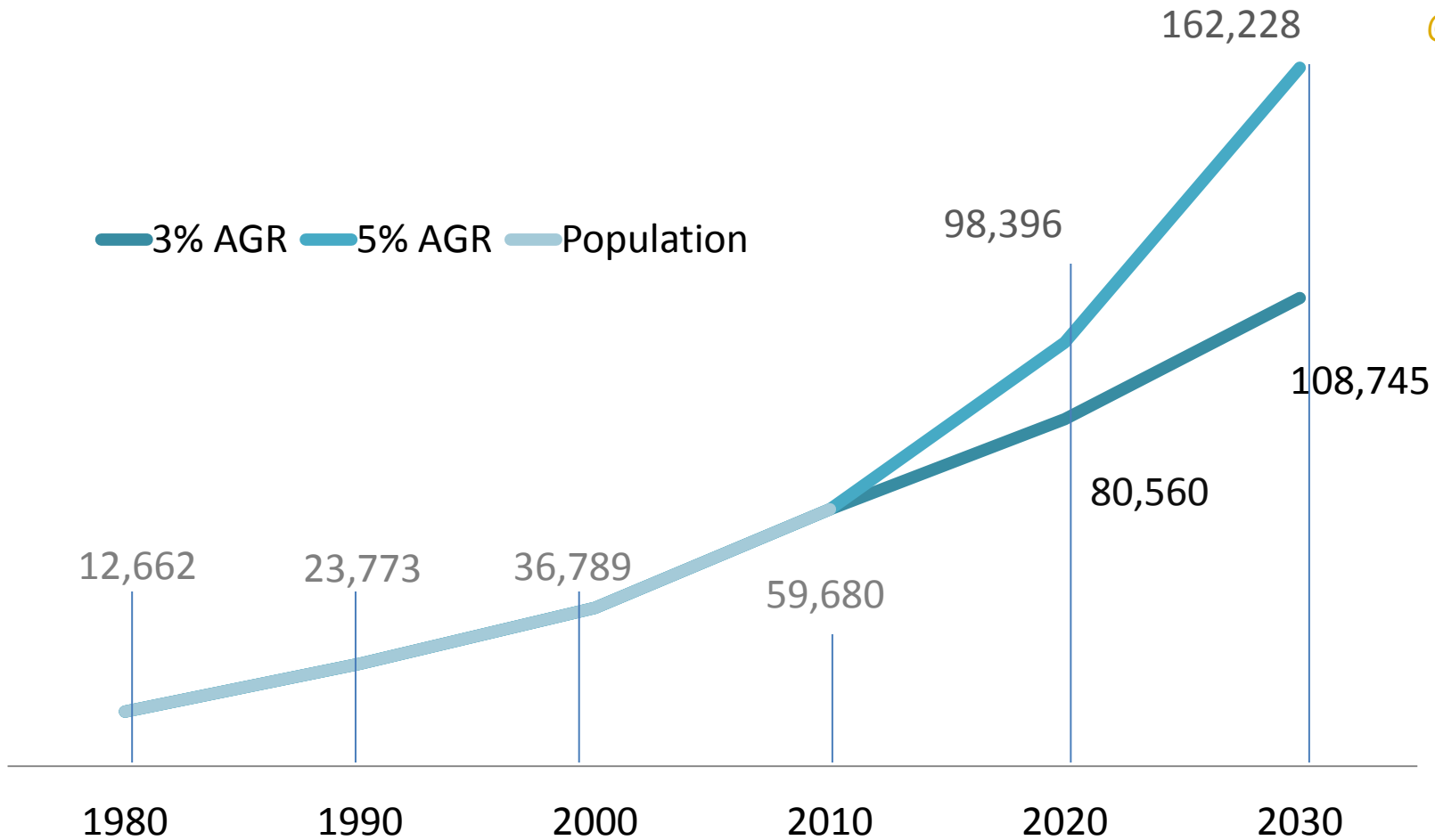

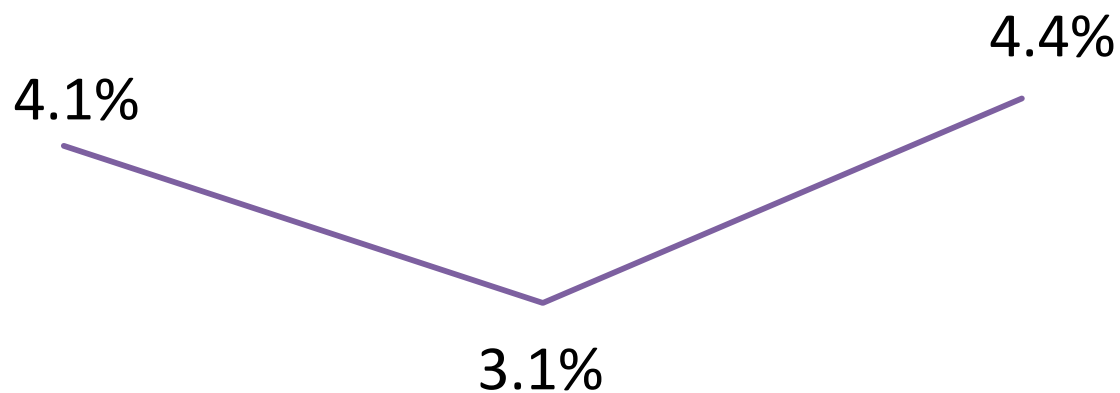

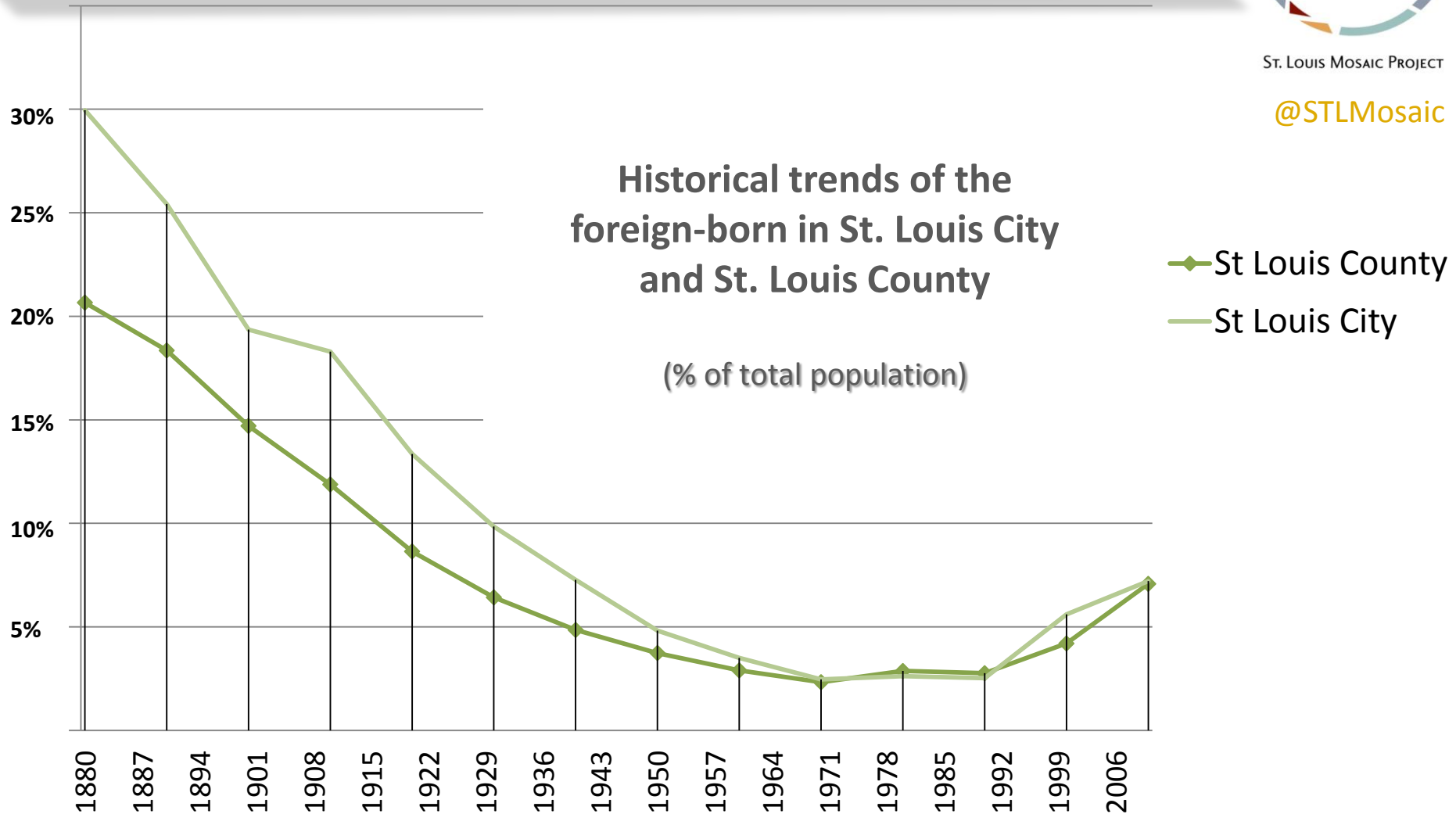

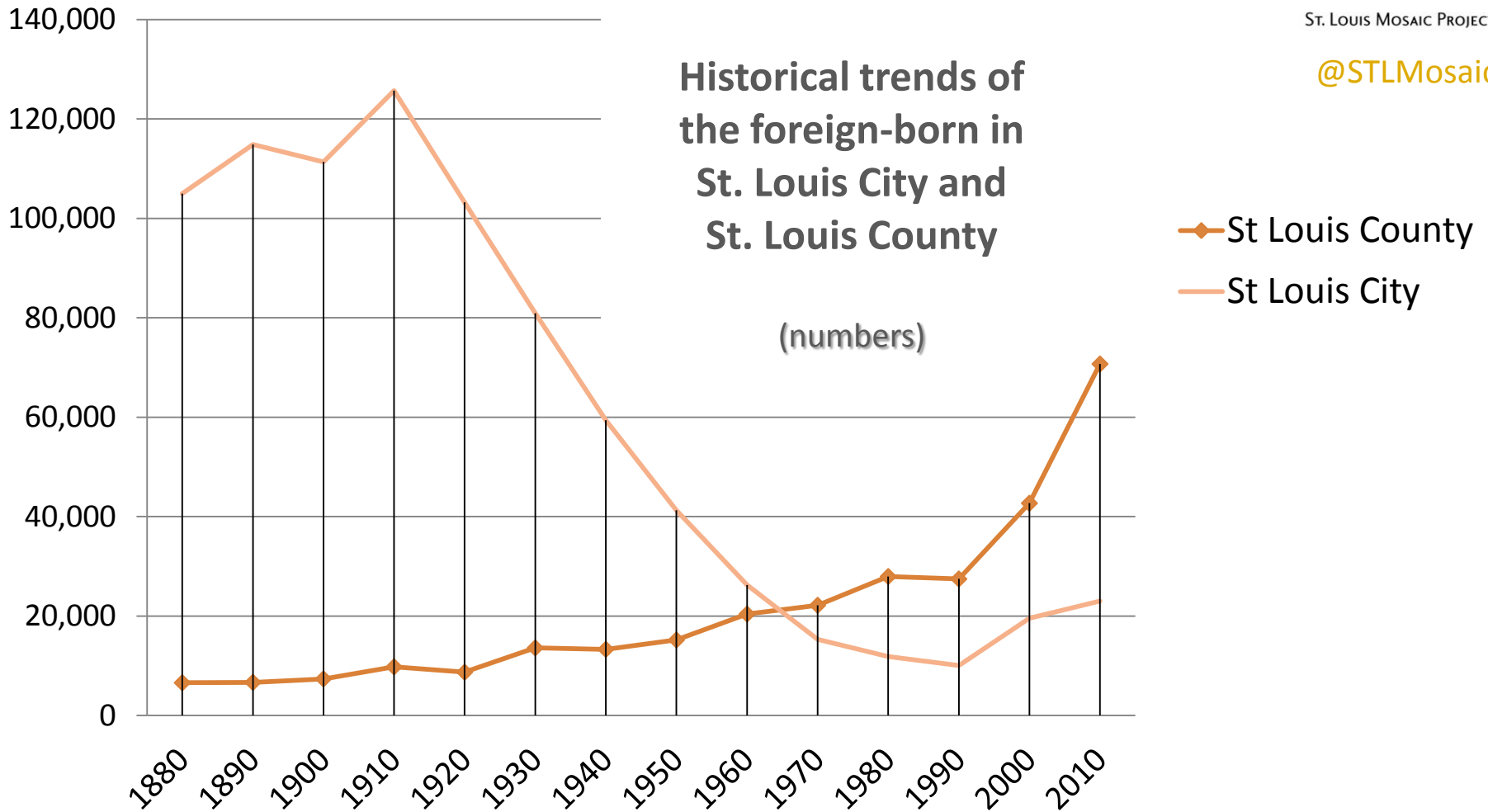

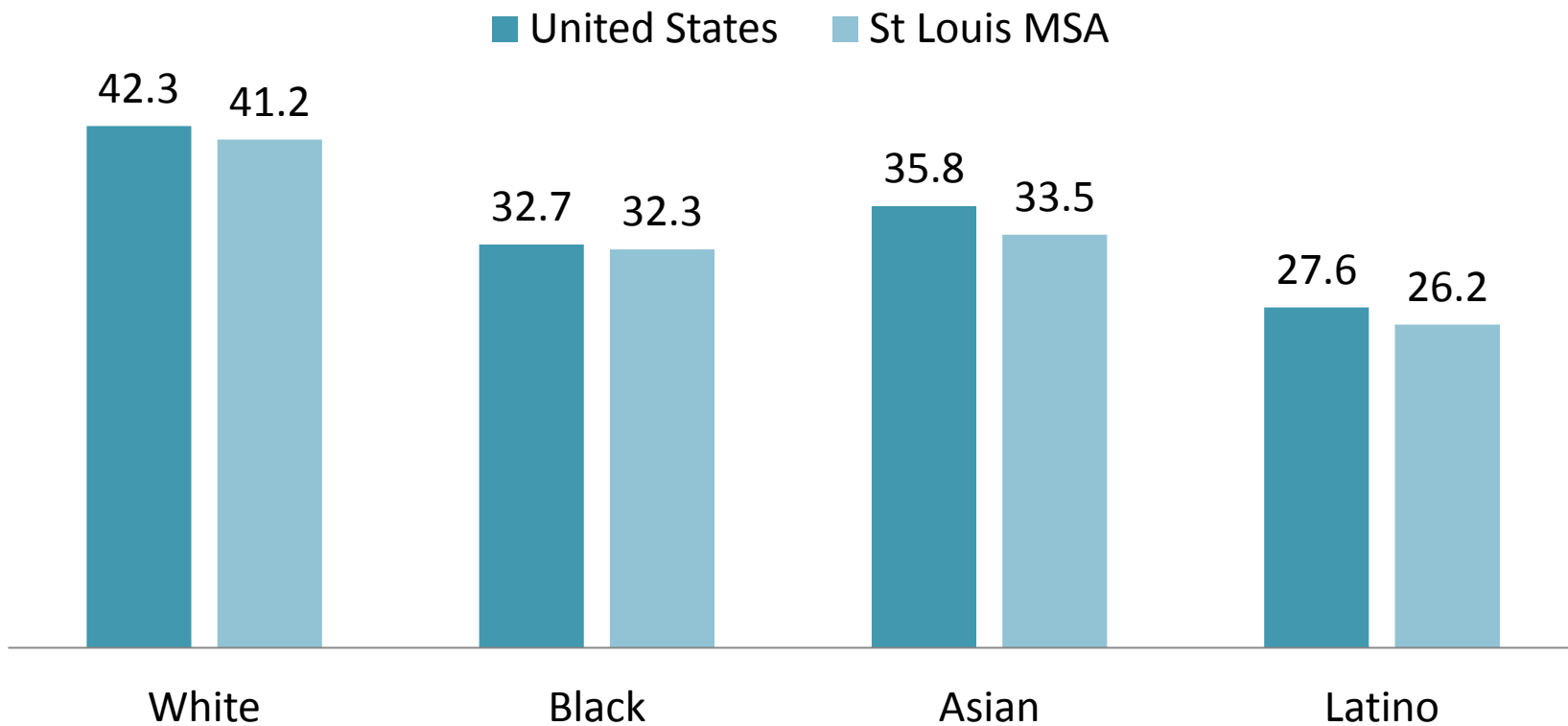

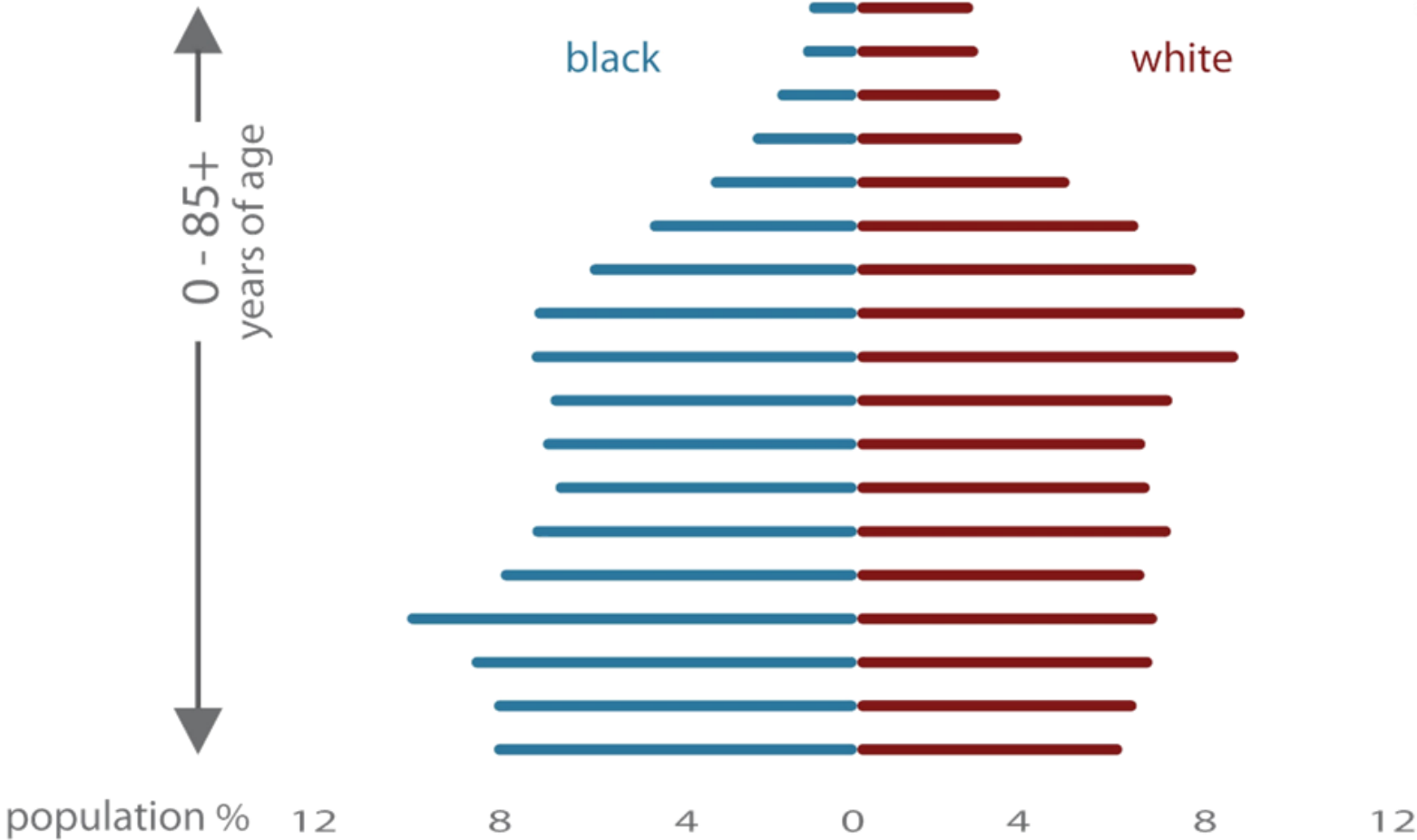


# POPULATION PYRAMID: black/white

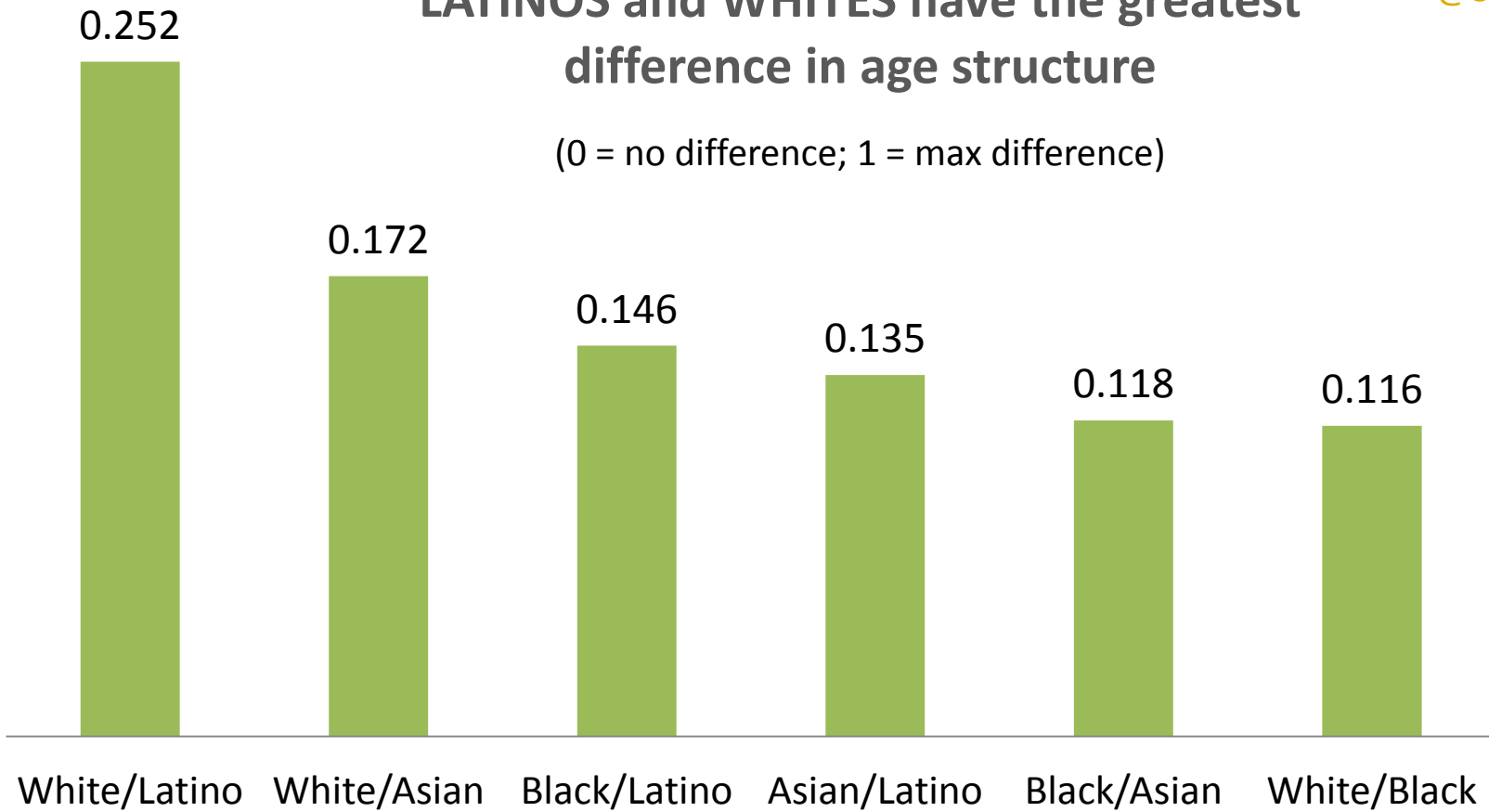

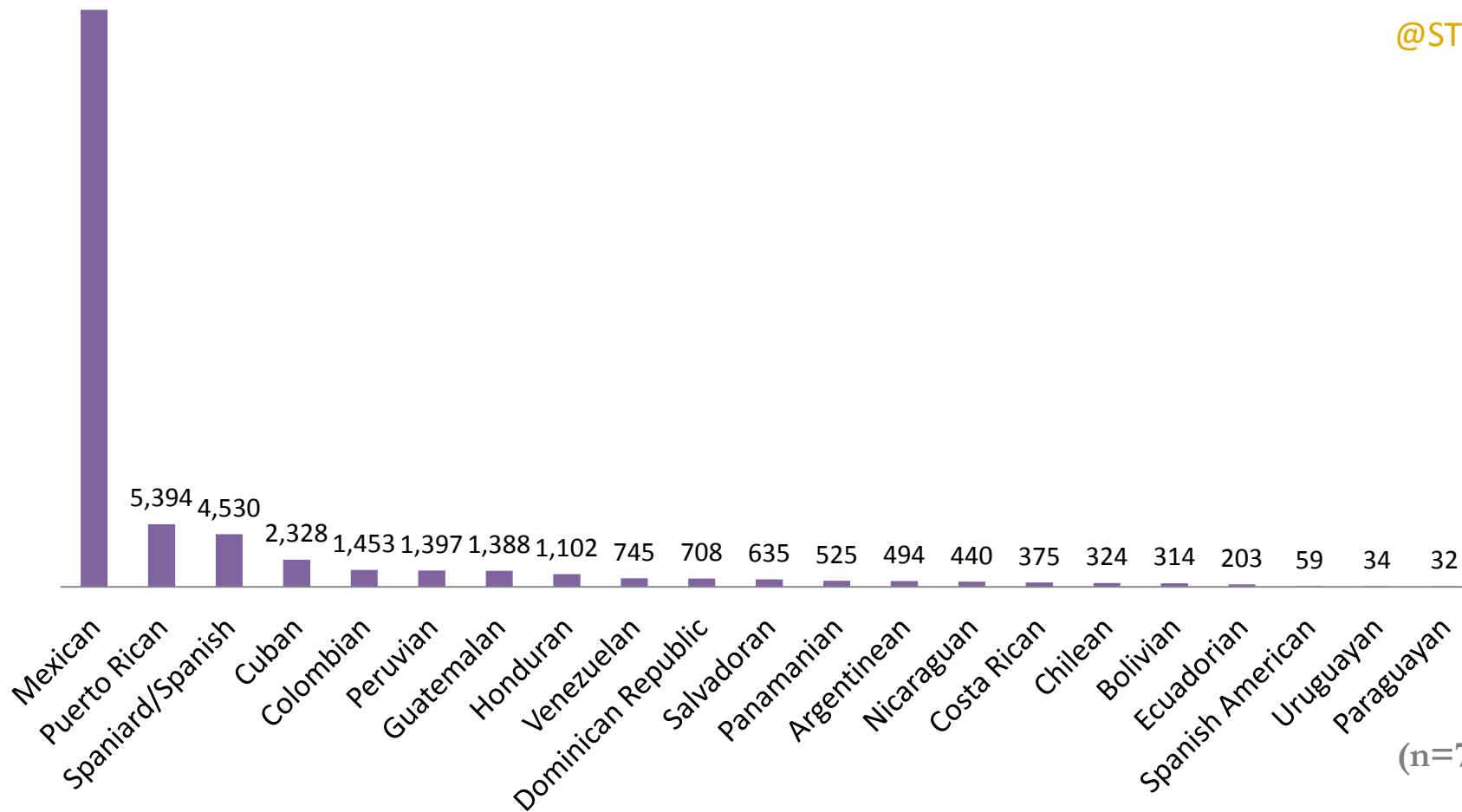

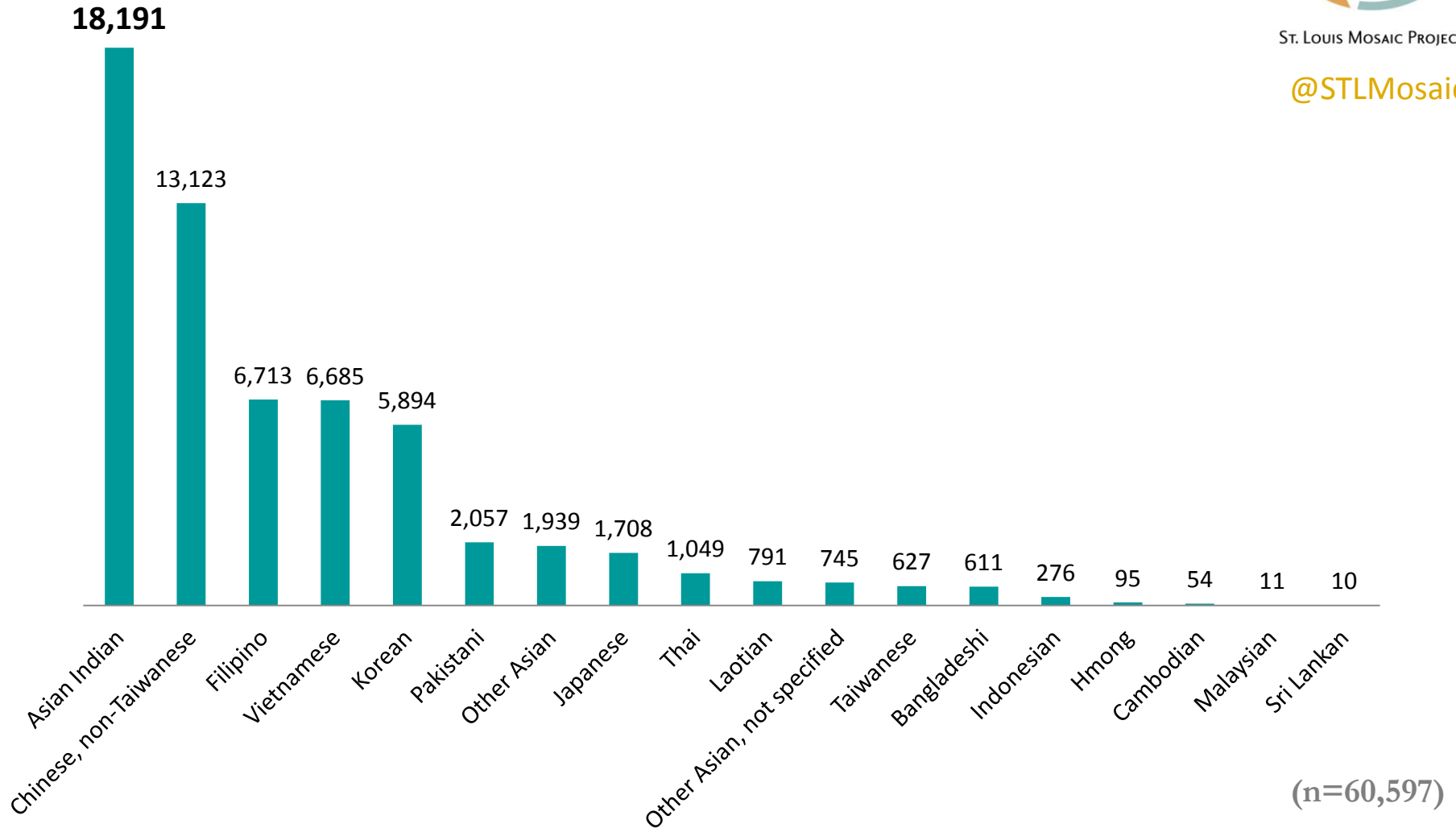

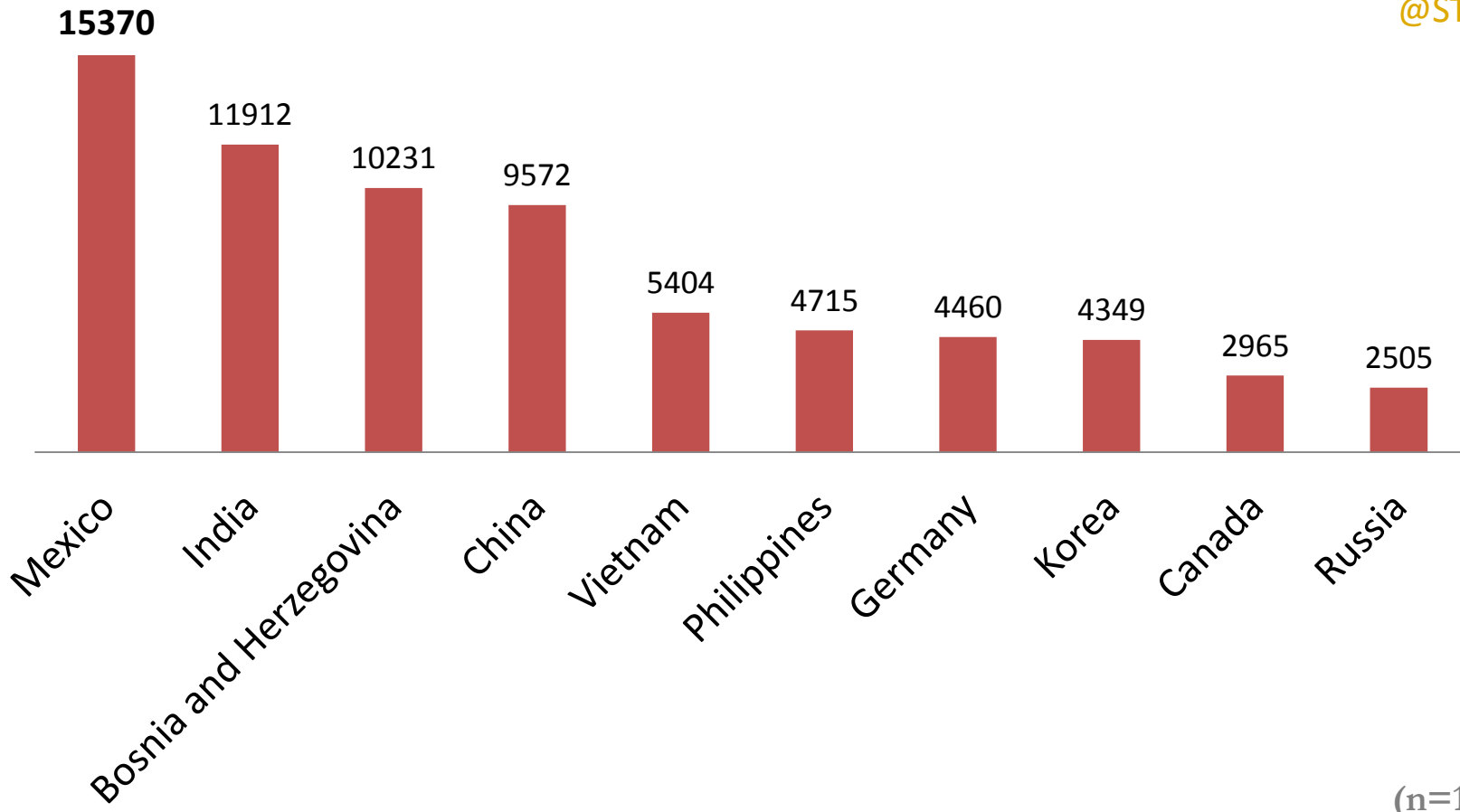

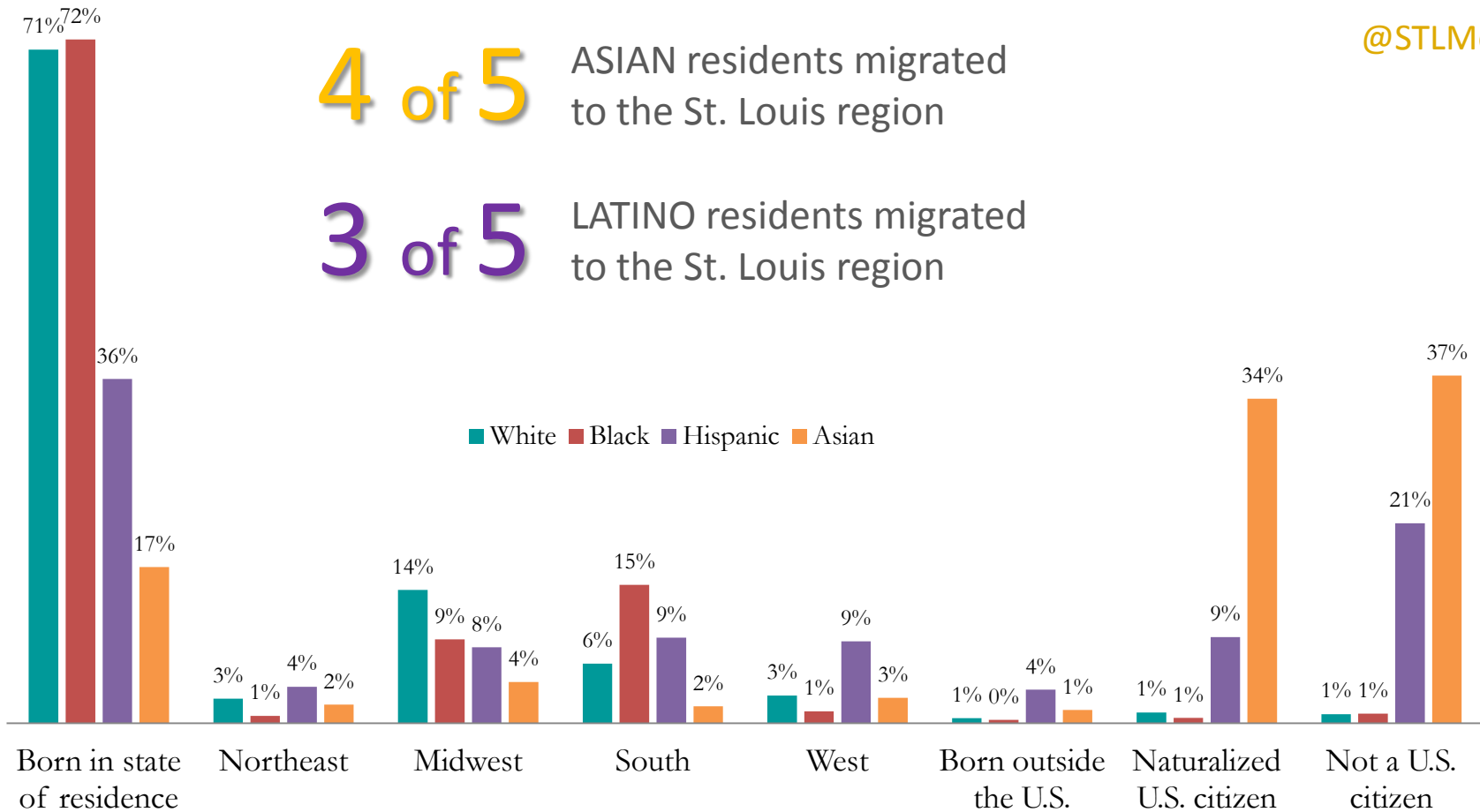

## POPULATION CURVES

- Significant ASIAN and LATINO population growth

## AGE COHORT DEMOGRAPHIC TRENDS

- LATINO residents are young and will continue to grow through birth and migration

## PANETHNIC DIVERSITY

- Panethnic ASIAN and LATINO populations and diverse immigrant population

## MIGRATION DEMOGRAPHIC TRANSITIONS

- The majority of ASIAN and LATINO residents are not from the region
