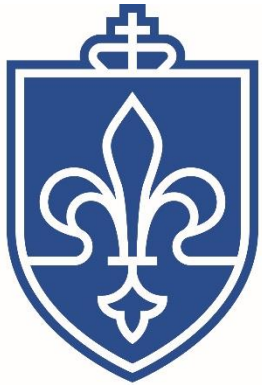

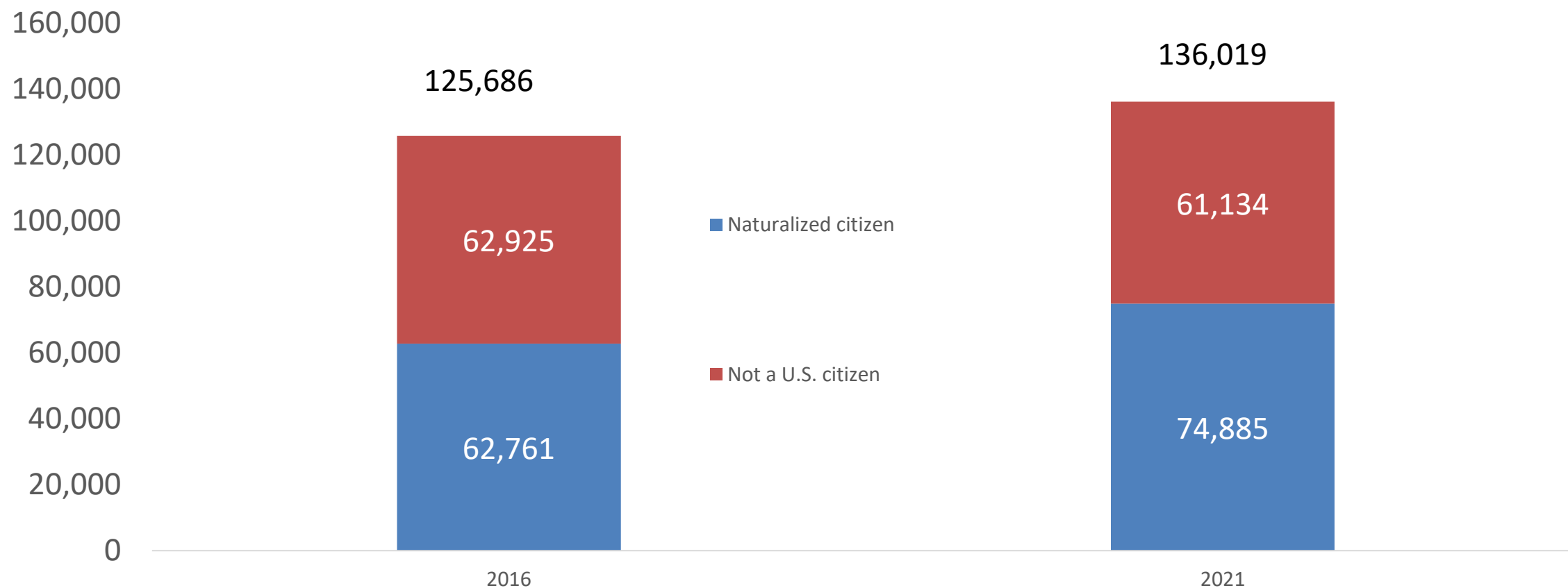

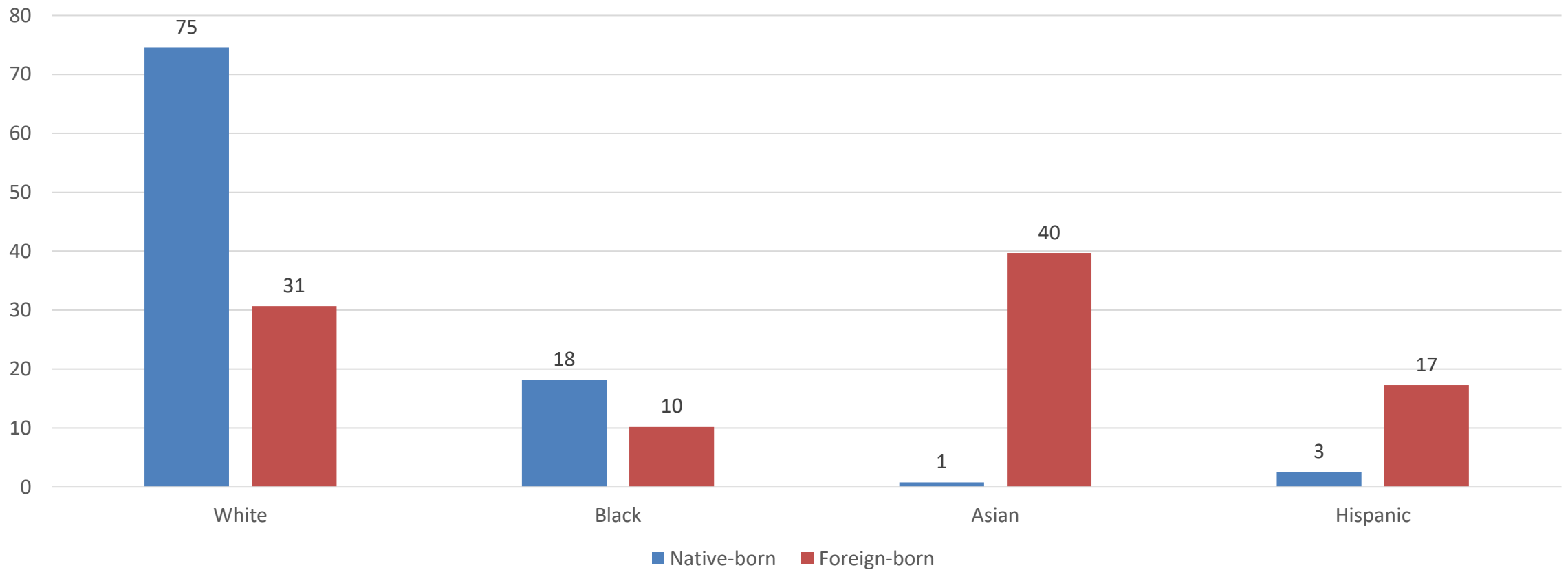

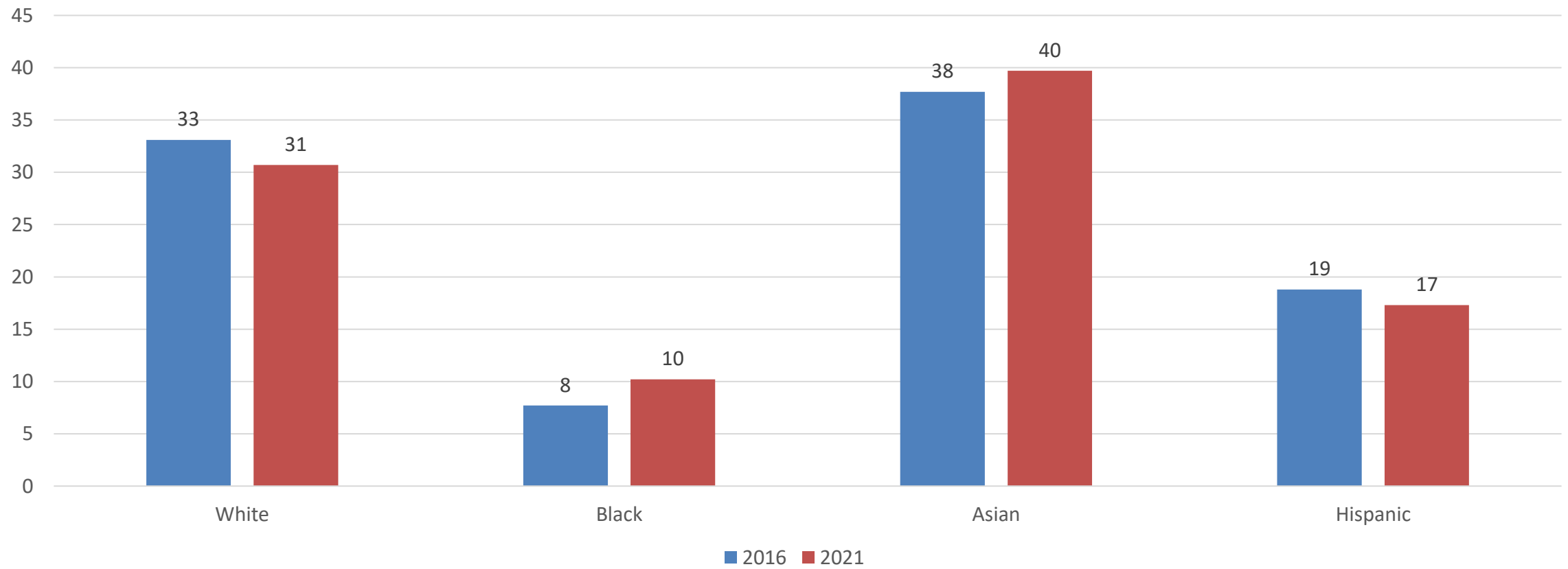


# There are some important shift in demographic characteristics

# Size of the Foreign-born population



- In 2010, Saint Louis had the 46<sup>th</sup> largest foreign-born population – 116K
  - Minneapolis is ranked 22<sup>nd</sup> - 301K
- In 2021, Saint Louis had the 46<sup>th</sup> largest foreign-born population -136K
  - Minneapolis is ranked 22<sup>nd</sup> - 390K

# In 2010

- Saint Louis had the 95<sup>th</sup> largest Mexican foreign-born population in the U.S.
- Saint Louis had the 40<sup>th</sup> largest Indian foreign-born population in the U.S.
- Saint Louis had the 27<sup>th</sup> largest Chinese foreign-born population in the U.S.

# In 2021



- Saint Louis has the 28<sup>th</sup> largest Indian foreign-born population in the U.S.
- Saint Louis has the 99<sup>th</sup> largest Mexican foreign-born population in the U.S.
- Saint Louis has the 27<sup>th</sup> largest Chinese foreign-born population in the U.S.

- The Indian foreign-born population continues to grow
- The Mexican foreign-born is declining but this is consistent with national trends
- Given the size of the Saint Louis MSA, about 50k Mexican foreign-born residents are missing
  - Nashville is ranked 47 – 36K, Kansas City is ranked 43 – 43K, Charlotte is ranked 35<sup>th</sup> – 52K, Portland is ranked 27<sup>th</sup> – 73K
